A crocheted baby blanket with popcorn stitches

- 1: 167 ch
- 2: 1 bts in the third (3.) cs from the crochet hook, 164 bts, 2 tcs (165)
- 3: 10 bts *1 pcs, 12 bts* 2 tcs **(165)**
- 4: 1 bts, 2 tcs **(165)**

Repeat 3rd and 4th row until the crocheted piece measures 80 cm. Continue to move the popcorn stitch 3 basic treble stitches to the right.

Border:

- 1: Crochet 1 dcs in the same colour as the blanket all the way around.
- 2: Change the colour for the colour of the border and crochet 1 bts all the way around.
- 3: *1 st, skip 2 stitches, 8 bts in the same stitch, skip 2 stitches*

Yarn required:

9 balls of baby yarn, grey1 ball of baby yarn, white

Abbreviations and symbols explanation:

st = slip stitch

bts = basic treble stitch

pcs = popcorn stitch

tcs = turning chain stitch

cs = chain stitch

dcs = double crochet stitch

* = repeat from * to *
